

Updating the User Database

Loading initial data and migrating data is covered by the same script.

Migrating the User Database

1. **Stop** the user-service.



Stop the **user-service** before importing the data. Since the user-service caches the data on start-up, it would still rely on old data otherwise.

2. **Extract** the migration files for the user database. They are located in **user_database_initialization.zip**.
3. **Transfer** the migration files for the user database to the MongoDB host.
4. **Migrate** the data in your MongoDB installation.

```
cd <your path to unzipped initial data>
<path to your mongo db installation>/mongo --verbose
setupInitialData.js
```

5. **Start** the user-service.
