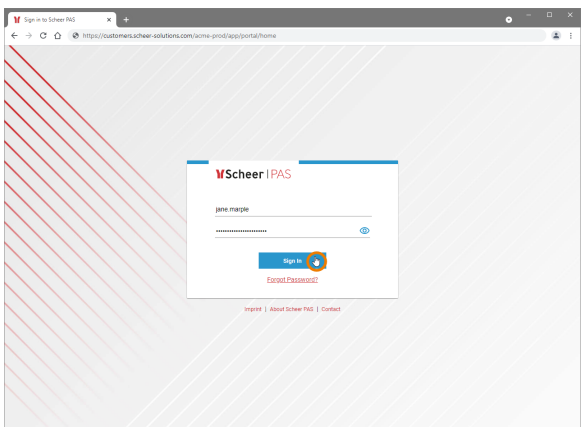


# Logging In and Out

## Logging in to Your System



To start working with **Scheer PAS**, you must first log in to your system. Go to your company's address, for example <https://customers.scheer-solutions.com/acme-prod/app/portal/home> and log in.

You need valid user data consisting of a username and a password. Enter the credentials in the corresponding fields and click **Sign In**. Alternatively, you can also confirm your input by pressing **Enter**.

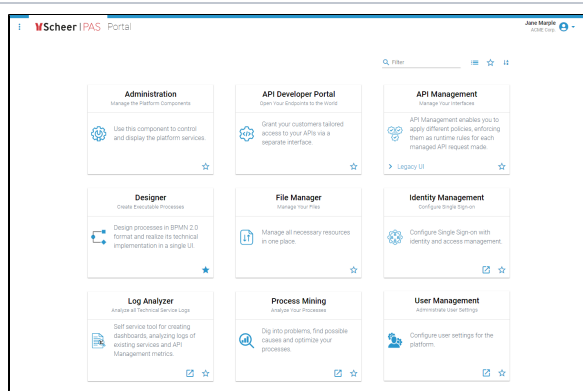

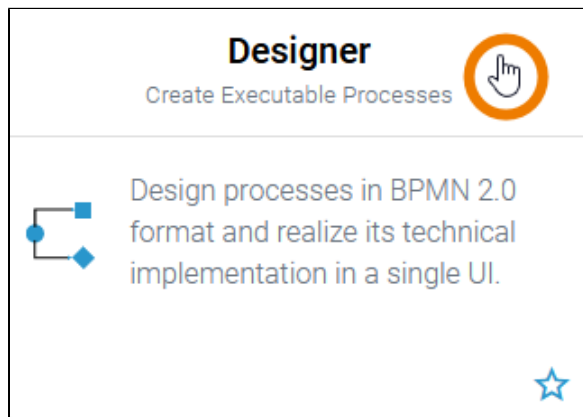

If you want to check your input for typos, use **Show**  to display your password.



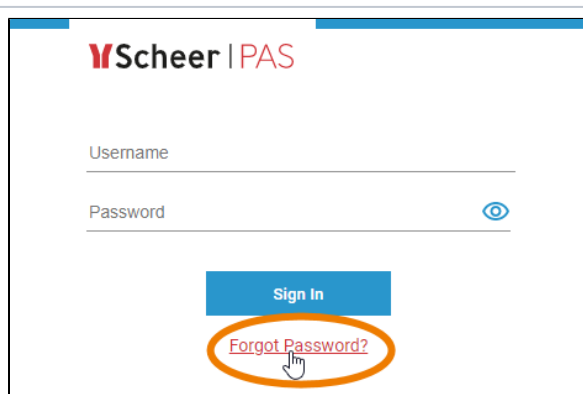

Click on a tile to open the corresponding component within the portal.










Click the Designer tile to open the Designer in a new browser tab.




## Forgotten Password



If you have forgotten your password, use the link **Forgot Password?** below button **Sign In**.


	<p>First enter your username, then click <b>Send New Password</b>.</p>
	<p>The following message will be displayed:</p> <p><b>An Email to reset your password has been sent.</b></p> <p>The email will be sent to the address stored for your account in the user administration.</p> <p>Check your mailbox.</p>
	<p>The email sent contains a link.</p> <p>This link is valid for 15 minutes.</p> <p>Click on the link to reset your password.</p>




	<p>The link takes you to a page where you can change your password yourself.</p> <p>Enter your new password in the first line.</p> <p>Confirm the new password by entering it again in the second line.</p>
	<p>If the password and the password confirmation do not match, you will not be able to submit your request.</p> <p>In that case, please enter your password again and make sure that your input is identical.</p>
	<p>Click <b>Show</b>  to view your input.</p> <p>This helps you to check your passwords for typos.</p>

	<p>Your password has also to match the password criteria.</p> <p>Hover over <b>Password Criteria</b>  to show the valid criteria.</p>
	<p>When you have entered the new password, click <b>Submit</b>.</p> <p>After a successful change of your password you will directly be logged in. You are redirected to the <b>Scheer PAS Portal</b>.</p>

## Logging out from Scheer PAS

There are several ways to finish your work in **Scheer PAS**.

	<p>Using <b>Logout</b> is the safest way to finish your work session: The current session is terminated in all tabs and the login page is displayed.</p>

	<p>Option <b>L</b>ogout is also available in the header menu if you have opened a tool in a separate browser tab.</p>
	<p>If you use one of the logout options, a screen will appear asking you to confirm that you wish to logout.</p> <p>After a successful logout, you are redirected to the login page.</p>
	<p>Alternatively you can close the browser tab, but this will not end your <b>Scheer PAS</b> session and is therefore not recommended.</p>
