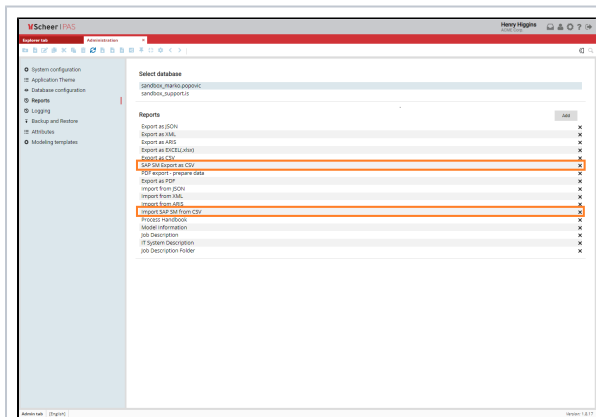


# SAP Solution Manager Integration

## Available SAP Solution Manager Integration report



There are two available SAP solution manager integration reports:

1. SAP SM Export as CSV
2. Import SAP SM from CSV

You can edit these standard reports in the **Reporting** menu in the **Administration Tab**.

The reports are generated as **.csv** file, including the information edited on the **Reporting** page.

## SAP SM Export as CSV

- Creates a report containing information about objects inside of a targeted model: **Id**, **Name**, **Object Type**, **Scheer Url** and **Sap Url**.
- It can be run on a **database**, **folder** or a **model**.
- Only **Functions** and **Documents** object types can be exported.

## Import SAP SM from CSV

- It can be run on a **database** or a **model**.
- It updates all the referenced objects it finds in the database/folder and saves the SAP URL into a predefined attribute.

## SAP Integration Process Steps

- The export is performed in the model editor.
- The exported **.csv** file is matched against the SAP data. Where a match is made, the model editor URL is saved to SAP, and a SAP URL is saved to a new file.
- The file with SAP URL is imported into the model editor.
