

To start working with Sch eer PAS, you must first log in to your system. Go to your company' address, for example https://c ustomer s.scheersolution s.com /acmeprod/app /portal /home an d log in.

You need valid user data consistin g of a usernam e and a password . Enter the credential s in the correspo nding fields and click Sign In. Alternativ ely, you can also confirm your input by pressing Enter.

Single Sign-on available througho ut all platform compone nts: Log in once, and use all Scheer PAS compone nts that are configure d for your user.



If the usernam e or the password do not match or contain typing errors, an error message is displayed on the login screen.

In a first step try again to log in with your usernam e and password . In particular, check that the input is case sensitive.


