



# Process Mining Specifics

## Inactive Profiles

As users of **Scheer PAS Process Mining** can create analyses for every process that is saved in one of their assigned profiles, they will notice if a profile has been disabled. If a profile is deactivated, the user will not be able to analyse the corresponding processes any more.



Already created analyses will show the message **No permission to analyse this process.**
