1. Navigation Bar:

From the administration's navigation bar you can...

- ... open the deployment wizard.
- ... reload the list of services.
- ... open the extended filter options.
- ... filter the list of services.
- ... open detailed license information.
- ... open the global variables view (PAS 24.0 Kubernetes setup only!)
- ... view the number of available services.

2. Service

List: The start page of the administration lists all available services and docker containers.



indicates a Docker container.



indicates an integration service.



indicates a Kubernetes workload.
