
Assigning Roles

If you have assigned a role to a lane element, you still have to define which users should hold this role. This must be done in the Scheer PAS User Management.



You can access the user management via the corresponding tile in the Scheer PAS Portal.

Only users with profile user_manageme nt_admin are able to access the user management.

- You can open the role datasheet.




Assigning Roles to Users


Use this role assignment option if only one user is affected, e.g. if a user is to be assigned a new role subsequently.




