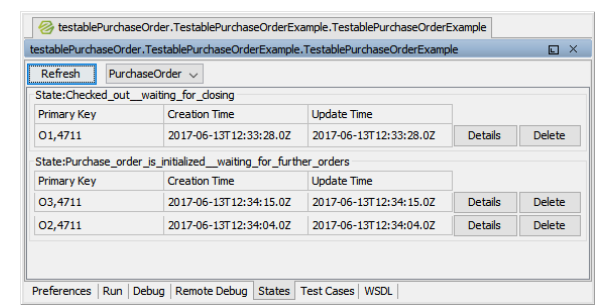


# Overview on the States View

Display Element	Description												
Refresh	Click <b>Refresh</b> to reload the window content to see changes.												
Persistent State Class Dropdown	Select a persistent state class. This is only relevant for services holding data in more than one persistent state class.
