

Replacement Text

The replacement text for find-and-replace operations may contain references to capture-group text from the find. References are of the form `$n`, where `n` is the number of the capture group.

Character	Descriptions
<code>\$n</code>	<p>The text of capture group <code>n</code> will be substituted for <code>\$n</code>. <code>n</code> must be <code>>= 0</code> and not greater than the number of capture groups. An unescaped <code>\$</code> not followed by a capture group specification is an error.</p> <div><p>If you want to specify the <code>\$</code> itself, you need to escape it with backslash like <code>\\$</code>.</p></div>
<code>\</code>	<p>Treat the following character as a literal, suppressing any special meaning. Backslash escaping in substitution text is only required for <code>'</code> and <code>\</code>, but may be used on any other character without bad effects.</p>
