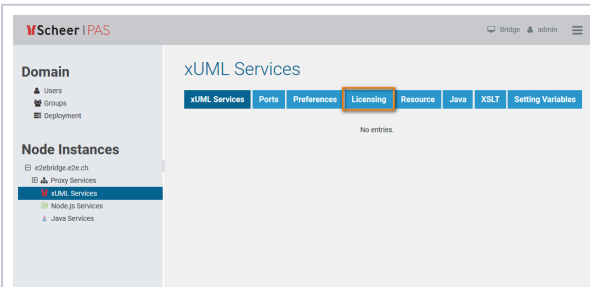


# Installing a Bridge License Key

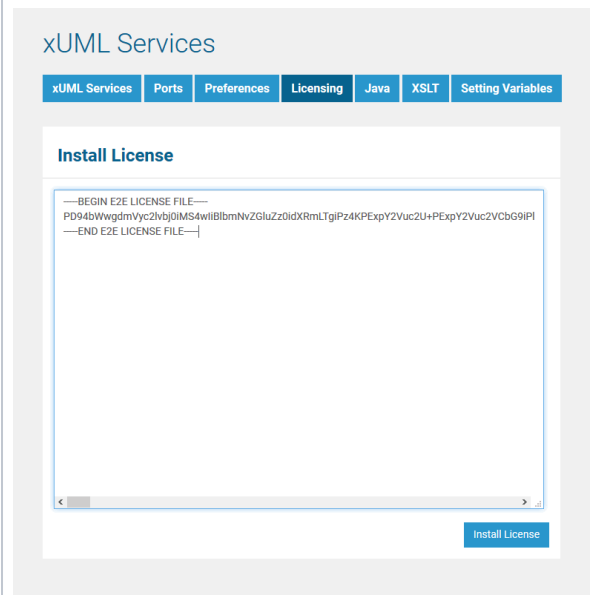
After successful installation, you need to install a BRIDGE license key as described below. You always need to install a BRIDGE license key. Otherwise, xUML, Node.js, or Java services cannot be started.

First, you need to select the node instance the BRIDGE is running on (here **e2ebridge.e2e.ch**). If the appropriate node instance is not yet selected in the **Node Instances** section of the navigation, click it to open its sub-navigation. Then, click the sub-navigation item **xUML Services** and switch to the Licensing tab in the information /working area.



Open the BRIDGE license key file in an editor and copy all content. Paste the key into the field **Install License** and click the button **Install License**.
