

# convertToDateTIme

Syntax	<pre>set aDateTimeObject = aString.convertToDateTIme() set aDateTimeObject = convertToDateTIme(LITERAL)</pre>	
Semantics	convertToDateTIme() converts the internal lexical representation of DateTime ("CCYY-MM-DDThh:mm:ss[.sss][z  [+ -]hh:mm]") to a <b>DateTime</b> type. If the conversion is not possible, an error message is raised (for instance: NULL strings).	
Substitutables	aString	Can be any variable or object attribute having the type <b>String</b> . The format must correspond to the lexical representation of DateTime.
	LITERAL	String literal. The format must correspond to the lexical representation of DateTime.
