

# convertToBoolean

Syntax	<pre>set aBoolean = aString.convertToBoolean() set aBoolean = convertToBoolean(LITERAL)</pre>	
Semantics	<p>convertToBoolean() returns true if the string true is passed as parameter. false is returned for all other values. Alternatively, the figures <b>0</b> for false or <b>1</b> for true can be used as parameters. If the conversion is not possible, an error message is raised (for instance: NULL strings).</p>	
Substitutables	aString	Can be any variable or object attribute having the type <b>String</b> .
	LITERAL	String literal.
Examples	<pre>set aBoolean = aString.convertToBoolean();</pre>
