Syntax	<pre>set aSubstring = aString.substring(startIndex, length) set aSubstring = substring(LITERAL, startIndex, length)</pre>	
Semantics	Extracts a substring of a given length beginning at position <code>startIndex</code> . Returns a new string. The state of the current string is not changed. If length is greater than the length of <code>aString</code> , an error is raised.	
Substitutables	<code>aString</code>	Can be any variable or object attribute having the type String .
	<code>startIndex, length</code>	Can be any variable or object attribute having the type Integer . The start index cannot be negative.
	<code>LITERAL</code>	String literal.
Examples	<pre>set aSubstring = stringSet.s1.substring(0, 2); // To get the last 5 characters of a string set endOfString = astring.substring(aString.length(-5), 5);</pre>
