

# convertToInteger

<b>Syntax</b>	<pre>set anInteger = aBoolean.convertToInteger() set anInteger = convertToInteger(true false)</pre>
<b>Semantics</b>	Converts boolean values to integers. true is converted to <b>1</b> , false to <b>0</b> .
<b>Substitutables</b>	aBoolean   Can be any variable or object attribute having the type <b>Boolean</b> .
<b>Examples</b>	<p>Converts the value of the boolean variable to an integer having the value <b>0</b> or <b>1</b>.</p> <pre>set i1 = b.convertToInteger();</pre> <p>Assigns <b>0</b> to integer <b>i2</b>.</p> <pre>set i2 = convertToInteger(false);</pre>
