The **Search** panel helps you to find elements in the model tab that is currently open.

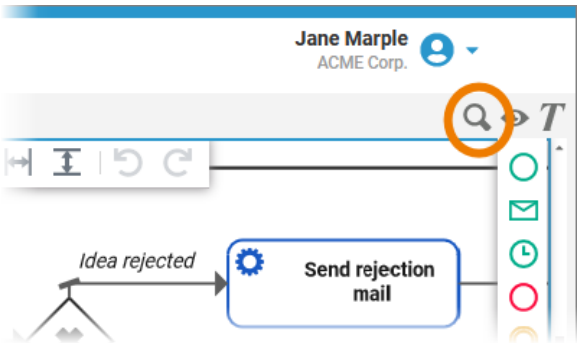


The panel is available for the following editors:

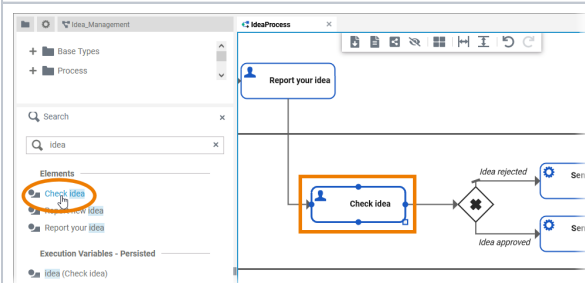

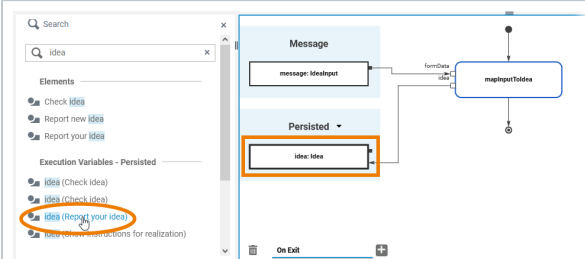

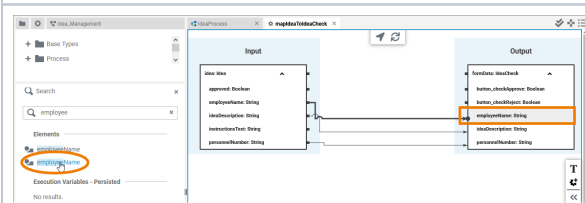
