Syntax	<pre>set aDateTimeObject = aString.convertToDateTime() set aDateTimeObject = convertToDateTime(LITERAL)</pre>	
Semantics	convertToDateTime() converts the internal lexical representation of DateTime ("CCYY-MM-DDThh:mm:ss[.sss][Z [+ -]hh:mm]") to a DateTime type. If the conversion is not possible, an error message is raised (for instance: NULL strings).	
Substitutables	aString	Can be any variable or object attribute having the type String . The format must correspond to the lexical representation of DateTime.
	LITERAL	String literal. The format must correspond to the lexical representation of DateTime.
Examples	<pre>set aDateTimeObject = aString.convertToDateTime();</pre>
