
Removing Libraries


You can remove a used library from a service. You can do this

- via the Asset Drawer
- via the Manage Libraries dialog
- via the context menu in the service panel

Removing a Library via the Asset Drawer



Open the Asset Drawer in the service where you use the library you want to remove.



To remove a library from your service, click Remove on the corresponding list entry.

A confirmation dialog opens.

Click Yes to remove the library from the service.




The library will be removed even if one or more elements of the library are still used in the service. In this case the implementation of the service may become invalid.


