



Removing Libraries

Removing a Library via the Asset Drawer


	<p>Open the Asset Drawer in the service where you use the library you want to remove.</p>






The related asset button changes back to **Add**. The library has been removed from the service and is no longer displayed in the service panel.

Open the **Manage Libraries** dialog in the service where you use the library you want to remove.



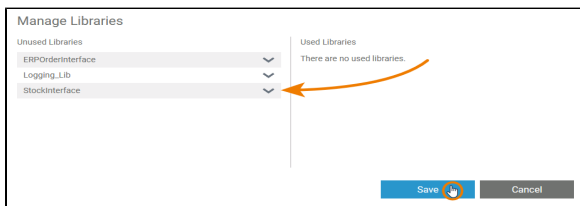
Click **Remove library** to remove the corresponding library from the service.

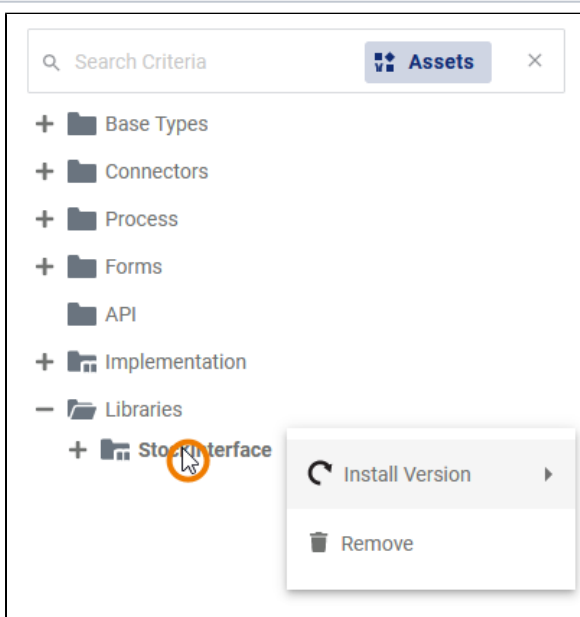
