

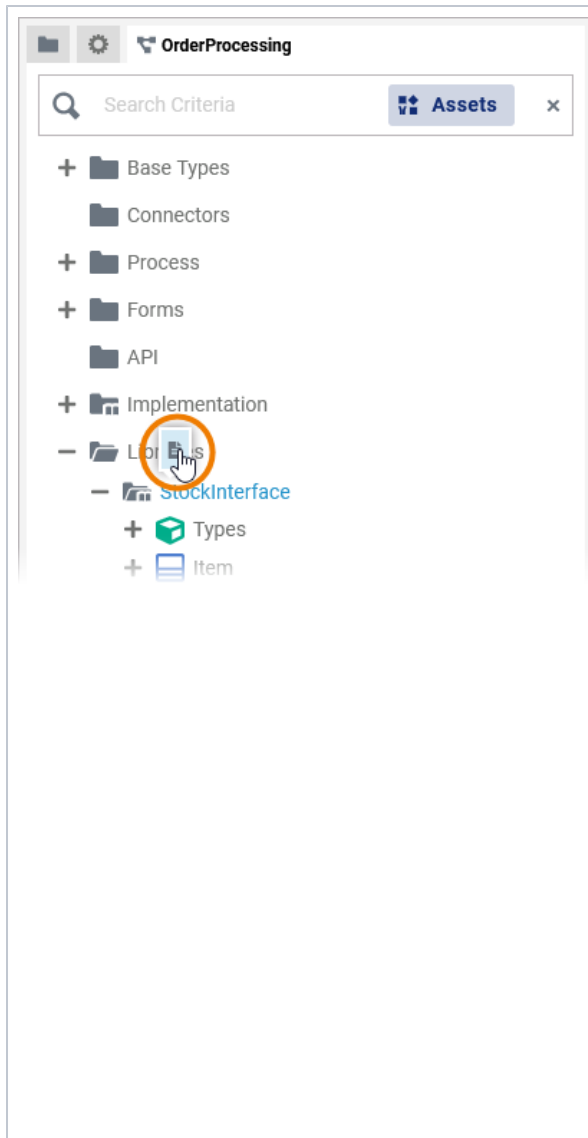
Accessing the Library's Documentation
