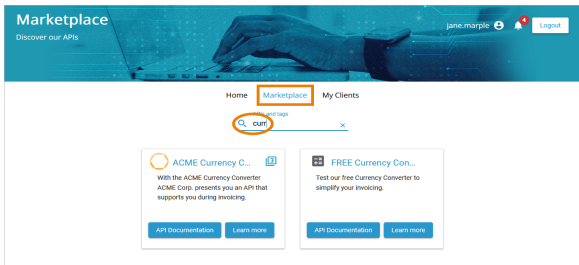

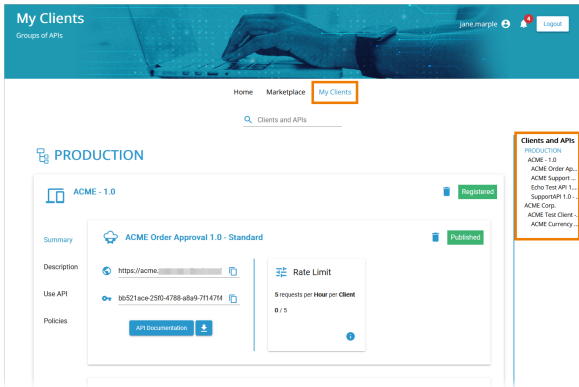

Marketplace

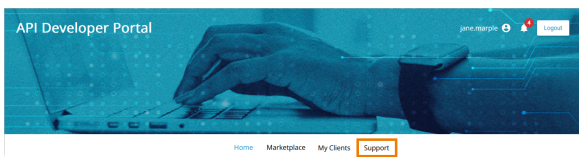
The **Marketplace** is where all published APIs are displayed. Developers can use the filter to search the whole variety of your APIs.

The navigation on the right side supports the user to browse the page.

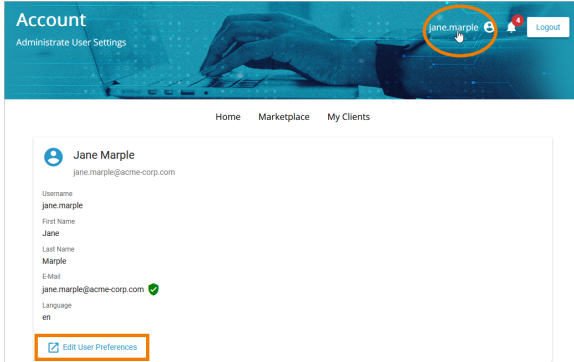


Additional Tabs

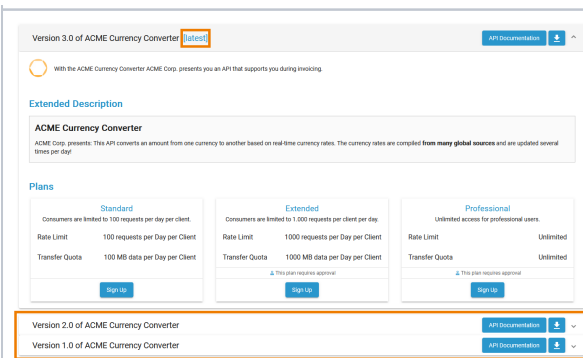

If you want to subscribe for an API, click Sign Up in the plan you want to register for (refer to [Developer Access to APIs](#) for details).



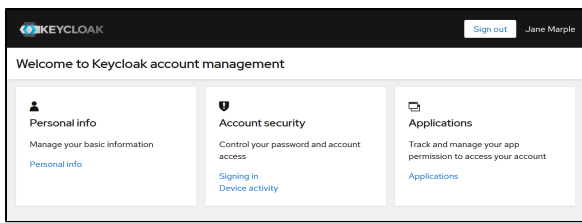


