



# Creating a Template from an Analysis

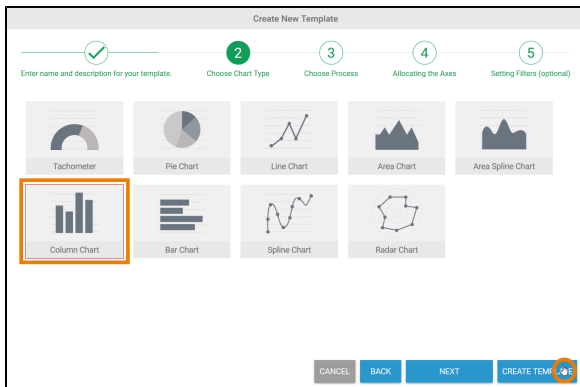
