
# **Single Connector**

The context menu displays all options available for the connector:



## Changing the Configuration of a Connector

To change the configuration of a connector, also use the Manage Connectors dialog.



You need to configure the connector from scratch and apply your changes. The old connector will be replaced by the new configuration.



Hover with your mouse over the  $\boldsymbol{\mathsf{C}}$ onnectors folder in t he service panel. Click the **↓**U icon to open the connector managem ent.
