


Local File Link Attributes



your loca Í file link.


Customizing the Attribute



Click on the icon next to the name of the link attribute to **Edit** attribute **name** in a new window.

If you did not upload an icon for the link attribute and you checked Display icon che ckbox, link attribute will show on canvas area as default link symbol.
