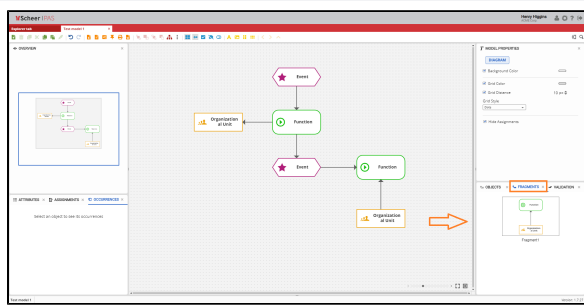


# Fragments

This is where you can see and use fragments created by you or any other user.

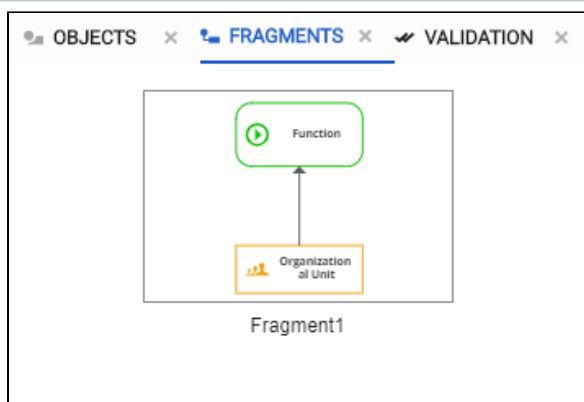
