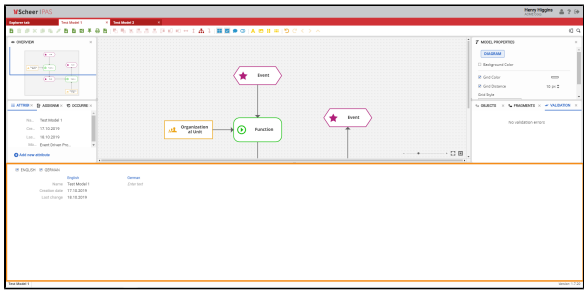


Language Panel

These system always tries to display an attribute value, even if the attribute is not available.

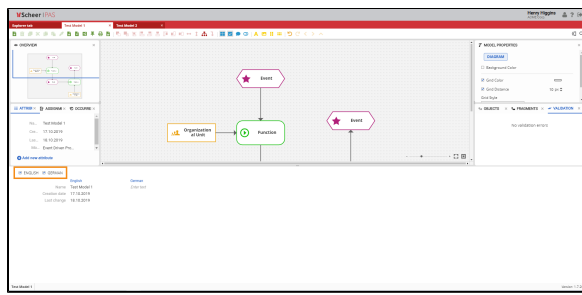
