

# Keyboard and Mouse Shortcuts

## Keyboards and Mouse Shortcuts Overview

Shortcut	Description
<b>DEL</b>	Removes selected items.
<b>ESC</b>	Removes selections and closes dialogs. Closing dialogs with the ESC key is the same as clicking Cancel.
<b>Page Up</b>	Moves the model window contents down (the contents of the model window that are further up will be displayed)
<b>Page Down</b>	Moves the model window contents up (the contents of the model window that are further down will be displayed)
<b>Minus key (-)</b>	Reduces the model by 10%
<b>Plus key (+)</b>	Enlarges the model by 10%
<b>Left arrow</b>	Moves the model window contents to the right (the contents of the model window that are further left will be displayed).
<b>Up arrow</b>	Moves the model window contents down (the contents of the model window that are further up will be displayed)
<b>Right arrow</b>	Moves the model window contents to the left (the contents of the model window that are further right will be displayed)
<b>Down arrow</b>	Moves the model window contents up (the contents of the model window that are further down will be displayed)
<b>Ctrl + A</b>	Selects all items
<b>Ctrl + C</b>	Copies selected items to the clipboard. This enables you to paste copied items from the clipboard into models/diagrams. If you paste items into a model, occurrence copies are created.
<b>Ctrl + V</b>	Generates occurrence copies of the selected items in the model
<b>Ctrl + Shift + V</b>	Generates definition copies of the selected items
<b>Ctrl + End</b>	Displays the bottom right pane of the window
<b>Ctrl + F</b>	Opens the Find dialog for you to search the entire database for items (selects search box)
<b>Ctrl + Left Arrow</b>	Moves selected items to the left by increments of one pixel.
<b>Ctrl + Up arrow</b>	Moves selected items upwards by increments of one pixel.
<b>Ctrl + Right arrow</b>	Moves selected items to the right by increments of one pixel.
<b>Ctrl + Down arrow</b>	Moves selected items downwards by increments of one pixel.
<b>Ctrl + Home</b>	Displays the top left pane of the model window.
<b>Ctrl + X</b>	Cuts selected items and copies them to the clipboard.
<b>Shift + Left arrow</b>	Moves selected objects to the left by increments of one gridline.
<b>Shift + Up arrow</b>	Moves selected objects upwards by increments of one gridline.
<b>Shift + Right arrow</b>	Moves selected objects to the right by increments of one gridline.
<b>Shift + Down arrow</b>	Moves selected objects downwards by increments of one gridline.

<b>F2</b>	Selects the object name of a selected object for editing.
<b>Shift + Page Down</b>	Switches to the next tab from left to right.
<b>Shift + Page Up</b>	Switches to the next tab from right to left
<b>Ctrl + Y</b>	Redoes editing steps that were undone.
<b>Ctrl + Z</b>	Undoes preceding editing steps.
<b>Ctrl + D</b>	Closes the active model window
<b>Ctrl + Shift + D</b>	Closes all tabs and opens(switches to) explorer tab.
<b>Ctrl + Left mouse button</b>	Enables you to include individual items in the selection one after the other or remove them from the selection.
<b>Scroll the mouse wheel</b>	Moves the model up or down
<b>Ctrl + Scroll the mouse wheel</b>	Reduces (scrolling down) or enlarges (scrolling up) the zoom factor of the model.
<b>Shift + Scroll the mouse wheel</b>	Moves the model to the right (scrolling up) or left (scrolling down).
<b>Ctrl + `</b>	Opens Explorer tab
<b>Ctrl + 1,2,3.....9</b>	Window/Number: When you open models, the first nine models are offered for activation in the Window menu. Press a number to activate the corresponding model and bring it to the foreground.
<b>Ctrl + M</b>	New model
