



All app data is saved in its own namespace. In field **Collection Name** you can define subnamespaces for the instances of **this precise start link** in the database.



As soon as a collection' s name is saved for a start link, its instances will no longer be saved in the same place as the data of the remaining start links of the project. We highly recommen d to use this option for trial only. Preferably define the name of the collection on the App Project.
