




Displaying Translations

How to Display Translations


	<p>After logging in to BPaaS, you can select the display language of the user interface in the user settings.</p> <p>Just click on the corresponding country flag.</p>
	<p>If English is selected, the user interface is displayed in English.</p> <p>The tiles, apps and EPKs are then also displayed in English - but only if the translations have been stored accordingly in the respective projects.</p>
	<p>Users who have selected German as the display language see the German display.</p>
