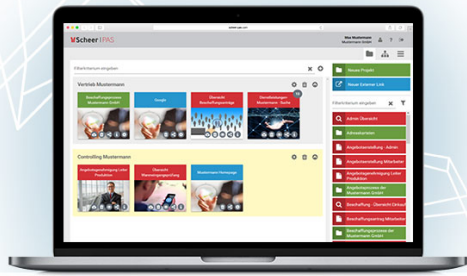

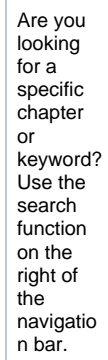

### Searching the Documentation






