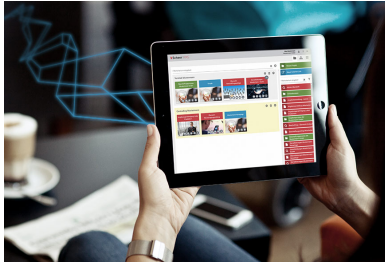


Starting BPaaS



The strength of **Scheer PAS BPaaS** is that it does not only allow you to model your business processes, but enables you to directly execute them as a business application. The description of a sequence of display forms leads to the creation of a web application. The forms - with the business process behind them - can be called up directly in the browser.

The business applications created in BPaaS are responsive and available on mobile devices without additional effort.

Since BPaaS is available in the cloud, i.e. it can be accessed from the internet, all you need is an up-to-date web browser installed on your computer - and off you go!
