





Logout and Help

Logging out from BPaaS

There are several ways to log off from **Scheer PAS BPaaS**:

	<p>If you use the logout button, the current session is terminated in all tabs and the login page is displayed.</p>
	<p>Alternatively you can close the browser tab.</p>
	<p>Or you can close the browser window.</p>




 For reasons of data security, the user may have to log in again because his session has ended in the meantime.


